Please read before submitting your sample

To help us handle your samples efficiently and to avoid delays

DO

- Please use our pre paid envelopes and clear bags to send samples in.
- Always send a request slip with your sample.
- Place the slip inside the postage bag (not in the sample bag).
- Clearly write your contact information, farmer details and test requirements on the slip.
- Send approximately 500g of sample, or 2/3 full of an A5 bag for silage and other forages. Send approximately 200g of fresh grass.
- Ensure sample bags are fully sealed before posting.
- Write sample references on the clear bag and on the slip, in case samples become separated.
- Write a separate slip for each sample type i.e. one slip for each type of silage.
- Water samples: write on the request form whether it is for Microbiology/ Mineral testing. Please package samples well, as these can get damaged in the post and leak. Send two separate bottles for each water test (Microbiology and Minerals).
- Feeds: Please write on the paperwork what you would like the feed testing for.

- Please do not put your request slip inside the bag with your silage sample.
- Please do not sellotape sample bags up, or tie up bags with cable ties, string or elastic bands.
- Do not sellotape or staple request slips to sample bags.
- Do not overfill the postage bags as they stick to the sample bag and it rips them open.
- Please do not put your sample directly into the postage bag.
- Do not mix different types of forage samples together. We are unable to test mixed forage samples using our normal NIR calibrations.
