I refer to your application for AEO authorisation received on 2 November 2018.

I am pleased to inform you that your application for AEO status has been successful. Your authorisation type is AEOF (Full).

Your authorisation number is GB AEO F/00277/18 and is effective from **19 March 2019**. This authorisation number should be entered on all correspondence with the AEO Central Site.

As an authorisation holder you are responsible for maintaining the standards applicable to the AEO status and for informing HMRC of changes in your business that would impact your status (Article 23(2) of the UCC refers).

All changes to be entered on to the C122 form and sent to AEO Central Site, using the contact details above, as and when changes occur.

Under Article 23(5) of the UCC, all AEO authorisations are required to be monitored on a regular basis. This work is undertaken by the AEO Central Site. Re-assessments are only carried out on an AEO authorisation under the circumstances set out in Article 15 of the Delegated Regulation to the UCC. However, HMRC may, using available information, determine that an audit visit is necessary and you will be contacted to arrange a suitable time for this work to be carried out.

### Data Sharing Agreements

This agreement ensures that you are recognised as an EU AEO business and you are in receipt of the appropriate benefits for that international supply chain movement.
